**ADDENDUM TO  
INTERNATIONAL MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN  
L'INSTITUT D'ETUDES POLITIQUES DE PARIS (FRANCE)  
AND  
NATIONAL CHENGCHI UNIVERSITY (TAIWAN, R.O.C.)**

Based on the terms set out in the **Memorandum of Understanding between** l'Institut d'Etudes Politiques de Paris (IEP de Paris) **and National Chengchi University (NCCU)** regarding exchange of students, faculty and researchers, l'Institut d'Etudes Politiques de Paris and National Chengchi University agree to implement the following in each of the academic years 2005 -2010.

**Part I: Exchange of students**

1. The number of students to be exchanged is limited to five graduate or undergraduate or Ph.D. students from each university per academic year. Each university will seek to achieve a balance in the number of students exchanged each academic year.
2. In principle, the duration of exchange of a student is limited to twelve months.
3. Each institution will facilitate the access of exchange students to scholarships, when possible.
4. Each institution shall, as part of the reciprocal nature of the exchange, waive the application fee, regular tuition and fees for the exchange students from the other institution. All other costs (for example, travel, dormitory, required medical insurance, books, meals, personal spending, off-campus lodging, incidental university fees, and language test fee) will be the responsibility of the exchange student.
5. The home university will send its students in accordance with the academic calendar of the host university. (The academic year of NCCU is from August to July of the following calendar year and IEP de Paris is from September to June of the following calendar year.)
6. In order to facilitate the exchange of students, both universities shall provide each other with necessary information on the application and registration requirements, including programs, school schedule, language tests, insurance coverage, etc.
7. An exchange student must have some basis in the language of the country of the host university. Recognizing that some additional training in the host country language may be beneficial, each university agrees to provide such training, if necessary, at the expense of the host university on a reciprocal basis.

8. Application for admission of an exchange student shall be presented to the host university in accordance with the regulations of the host university and at least six months prior to the beginning of the semester/term for which the student is applying.
  9. The host university shall, based on its own regulations, issue to a visiting student a certificate of academic records for studies completed during the exchange period, whereas the final credits to be awarded to the exchange student shall be based on the regulations of the home university.
  10. The host university will provide assistance in applying for housing. All students are required to pay for housing at the host university during the exchange period.
  11. An exchange student shall also respect and follow the regulations of the host university. The host university has the right to deport an exchange student who performs substantially below the standard set by the regulations of the host university.


## **Part II: Exchange of faculty and researchers**

12. Each university may arrange for members of its faculty and/or research staff to visit the other university for research and/or teaching. The maximum number of visiting faculty and/or research staff from one university to the other will be twelve per academic year and the maximum total accumulated time of all visits within one academic year will be twelve months. Both universities should try to equalize the number per academic year of visiting faculty and research staff as well as the total accumulated time per academic year of all such visits between the two universities.
13. A visit will normally not exceed a period of six months. Office space will be provided by the host university, whereas all other costs for the visit (travel, lodging, meals, other personal expenses, required health insurance, etc.) will be paid for by the visiting faculty and researcher.
14. Salary of the visiting faculty and researcher for the visiting period will be provided by the home university.

## **Part III: Additional terms for exchange**

15. Specific details of the exchange of students, faculty and researchers are to be decided by further consultation between the two universities.




